CCCN BOARD NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS

POLICY:

The following is the policy for the CCCN's Board of Directors nominations and elections process.

Composition

The composition of the Board shall be a minimum of eight (8) and a maximum of fifteen (15) directors. The Board shall be comprised of:

- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as President;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as President Elect;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Past-President;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Secretary Treasurer;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, Professional Education;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, Health Promotion and Advocacy;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, Research;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, National Conference;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, Publications;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, Membership;
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Director, Provincial Divisions; and,
- One (1) individual who shall have voting member status elected as Student nurse representative

The Board may also be comprised of up to three (3) directors at large who may be non-members and serve a one year renewable term. Nominations for directors at large shall be presented by directors and appointed by the Board by resolution.

Term

The term of office for directors is three years and the term commences following the Annual General Meeting in the year in which elections are held.

Nominations

The membership will nominate directors to the Board in accordance with the procedures that support this policy. In the event no director is nominated for election to the Board, the Board shall have the authority to appoint a director who will be confirmed by the membership at the next meeting of members.

Voting Eligibility

Voting for the election of directors is restricted to members of the Canadian Council of Cardiovascular Nurses.

PROCEDURES:

Directors

A call for nominations will be sent out at least 45 days prior to the Annual General Meeting to all members with a request to respond by a specified date which will not be later than 21 days before the Annual General Meeting.

All nominations shall be accompanied by the signed consent of the nominated member and by the signature of the member supporting the nomination. Both must be members in good standing. Nominations must be submitted by the date indicated on the notice along with a brief biography of the nominated individual.

When the names of those nominated are received at the National office, by the date specified, an election ballot listing all nominees will be forwarded to each member as part of their Annual General Meeting package.

Directors at Large

Nominations for directors at large are not mandatory, but when they occur, shall be presented by a director of the Board. All nominations must include information on the individual and the reasons the individual would make a contribution during the one year term he/she would serve on the CCCN Board. The individuals to be nominated for directors at large must provide consent to let their names be considered by the Board.

Pre-requites for Directors

The following pre-requisites are required for nominations to be considered for these positions:

- President must serve at least 1 year on the Board of Directors
- Director, Provincial Divisions must have served as a Provincial Director
